
With one of the best *parks* of the city, Hudson River Park, there is plenty of *open space* for *fitness, well-being* and activity.

Little Island is a new public park, where you can experience nature and art in a unique urban oasis on the Hudson River.






Intimate eatery offering Emilia-Romagna dishes, outdoor seating and private dining in a wine cellar at Nonna Beppa.




Shuka is place for contemporary Eastern Mediterranean food, wine and cocktails in a stylish setting.
